A massive volcano 30,000 years ago created 3 kilometer wide caldera. Now Lake Batur fills half of the ancient caldera and the active Volcano Mount Batur occupies the other half. ✂ Excursion Celuk : Gold & Silver Work, Mas : Wood Carving Center Ubud : Traditional Painting Goa gajah : Elephant Cave- The temple is characterized by menacing faces



	<p>that are carved into the stone – whose purpose is assumed to be the warding off of evil spirits. The primary figure was once thought to be an elephant, hence the nickname Elephant Cave. Each of the sea temples was established within eyesight of the next to form a chain along the south-western coast. In addition to Balinese coast.</p> <p>✂ After lunch proceed to visit Monkey Forest in Alaskedaton and Tanah Lot Temple for spectacular of sunset..</p>
DAY 4:	<p>ULAWATU SUNSET TOUR WITH KECAK AND FIRE SHOW</p> <p>✂ Breakfast at Hotel</p> <p>✂ After Breakfast Transfer to “Tanjung benano” beach for Water Sport Include 01 Round Banana Boat Ride (Other activities pay by own)</p> <p>✂ Lunch will be served at Indian Restaurant.</p> <p>✂ Transfer to Uluwatu temple -Ulu means the ‘top’ or the ‘tip’ and watu is ‘stone’ or ‘rock’ in Balinese. Several archaeological remains found here prove the temple dates back to around the 10th century. There are 2 entrances to Uluwatu Temple, one from the south and the other from the north. The views from the bottom of the water surging up against rocks and the ocean horizon are breathtaking.</p> <p>✂ Kecak dance show and Fire show A Kecak dance performance based on the Ramayana is performed daily in Uluwatu temple on the cliff-side</p>
